

# Alfred Aubertin

Paris, France

- 1870 Jules Aubertin (1839-1905) is a musical instrument maker in Marne, France (directory)
- 1872 Jules Aubertin, inst maker, 45 rue d'En Bas (dir)
- 1874 son Alfred Aubertin born in Montmirail (*NLI*)
- 1882 Jules granted patent #146781 for valves
- 1894 Alfred Aubertin, mechanic, Chateau Thierry (dir)
- 1905 Jules dies in Chateau Thierry; son Alfred is a mechanic living at Kings Mill Lane; Alfred's son Louis is born
- 1920s Alfred may have been working for Courtois
- c.1930 Alfred may have been making Besson Meha trumpets under license for SML Alliance (Strasser Marigaux Lemaire) at 144-146 Boul. De la Vilette, Paris (bottom three photos)
- 1935 Alfred & Louis establish trumpet making business in Aubervilliers, France, near Paris; #10 rue Bordier
- 1957 Alfred dies leaving the business to son Louis
- 1968 Louis ends the business

His trumpets were only professional level and favored by players like Maurice Andre and Roger Delmotte.
