

# Durand

## Paris, France

A number of brass instruments from the late 19<sup>th</sup> or early 20<sup>th</sup> century show up with the “Durand / Paris” markings and proceeded by either “Jules”(photos 1-3), “A” (photo 4), or “H” (photos 5&6). There is no listing for this name in Paris and these are most likely stencils made in Austria with the French name added to make them more appealing to the US market.

The Jules Durand alto horn below is also marked “Root & Sons Music / Chicago”.
