

Halary

Paris, France

- 1804 established by Jean Hilaire Aste (1775-1840) who used the name Halary-Aste; rue de Malte 12
- 1815 made keyed bugles for a Russian duke
- 1817 now at rue Mazarine 37
- 1825 retired and succeeded by Jean Louis Antoine (1788-1861) who used the name Antoine Halary or Halari
- 1849 now at rue Mazarine 33
- 1856 now at rue Poitevins 6
- 1857 started using name A. Halary & fils and advertised a branch in London
- 1859 licensed to build Sax model brass instruments
- 1861 succeeded by son Jules
- 1863 built new "Cornet – Solo"
- 1872 workforce of 35 included ten children
- 1873 sold to Coste & Cie, Sudre proprietor [many instruments (bottom right & below) are marked Halari – Sudre and probably date to after 1873]
