

Marceau & Co.

Paris

This was an inexpensive line of band instruments sold through Sears in the early 1900s. Not shown in their 1902 catalog but the illustrations here are from their 1908 catalog. Based on styles found, these were probably sold into the 1930s. Although they say "Paris", many are marked "B&F" or "Austria" which would make Bohland & Fuchs of Graslitz the actual maker and the French name a marketing ploy.
