- 1913 NY Musical Inst. Co., 12 Cooper Sq. W., NYC, importers & manufacturers of musical instruments (dir)
- 1915 NY Musical Inst. Co., 12 Cooper, Max Renz & Louis Ortlieb
- 1917 NYMI Co., #10 Cooper Sq. (dir)
- 1920 NYMI Co. & NY Band Inst. Co., #56 Cooper Sq. (dir)
- 1920 Louis Ortlieb, b. 1872 in Switzerland, emigrated in 1884, naturalized in 1893; music store owner in NYC (census)
- 1921 photo of store at #111 E. 14th St. (top right); they are a dealer for Buescher band instruments
- 1922 selling Alexander French horns
- 1925 Ortlieb family is now in Rochester; Louis and two sons are running a music store there so he must have sold the NY store by then (census)
- 1946 NY Band Inst. Co., #1166 6th Ave. & #111 E. 14th St. (dir)
- 1946 NYBI Co., #270 4th Ave. & #1166 6th Ave. (dir)
- 1949 NYBI Co. is exhibiting at a convention
- Undated ad shows them selling Buescher, Toneking, & Harmony band instruments as well as Alexander French horns; #111 E. 14th St.

Models sold with their label include “Toneking”, “The Regal”, and “Harmony”. Most are Austrian made probably by Julius Keilwerth of Grazlitz. (Czechoslovakia after 1918)
