1895 William marries Anna Paulus in Cleveland  
1897 son Clifford Paulus Barnes is born in Cleveland  
1900 Wm E Barnes, musician, #29 Barber Ave (census)  
1910 Barnes a professor at the West Side Musical College in Cleveland (2<sup>nd</sup> from left in photo 2)  
c1917 son Clifford is studying trumpet at the New England Conservatory at Boston  
1918 home at #2810 Scranton Rd, Cleveland; son Clifford is home and playing trumpet for the Strand Theater in Akron, OH (draft); a William Barnes writes music for the songs "Everybody Hit for Victory" and "The Self-Same Man" (not certain if same WB)  
1921 Wm W Barnes is vp of music college (directory ad below)
