Dates are estimated based on the 1880 start date, 1903 change to "Company", 1917 introduction of the Boss-Tone trumpet, 1921 change to Model 11 trumpet, and 1928 USQMC contract.

1936 “The Cundy-Bettoney Company still makes some of these cornets and trumpets which had no real competition until 1915.” [quote from Ayers interview with C-B in 1936 which would throw off the dating above]

1939 A Mr. V. G. Latham of Boston is mentioned as the president of BMIC. A brochure for the Model 11 three star trumpet has a stamp “For Sale By The Cundy-Bettoney Company, Bradlee St, Hyde Park, Boston” which would date this to the late 1930s when they moved to that location.

1955 The company is officially dissolved on March 23rd.
