Vincent C. Buono

Brooklyn, New York

- 1875 Vincent Carmine Buono (photo 1) was born on August 3 in Salerno, Italy (immigration paper).
- 1890 Buono arrives in New York (immigration).
- 1900 Buono is working as a musician and living in Brooklyn (census).
- 1901 Buono was hired by Columbia Phonograph Co as a trumpet player on recordings (Trescott).
- 1918 Buono is living at 468 Franklin Ave in Brooklyn and working for Columbia (WWI draft record).
- 1922 Buono left Columbia to join the New York Symphony Society under Walter Damrosch as principal trumpet (Trescott).
- 1928 Buono left the symphony when they were combined with the New York Philharmonic.
- 1940 Buono was a music studio teacher living in Brooklyn (census).
- 1959 Buono died on June 3 in Brooklyn (Trescott).

A trumpet mouthpiece was found (photo 2 by author) but it's unknown who actually made it. He may have been selling them to students in the 1930s and 1940s.
