

Cantabile Pocket Trumpets

Osaka, Japan

The following history was supplied by Kazuhiro Sanada of Sanada & Co, Tokyo and originally sent to Robb Stewart.

- 1892 Ueno Gakki Manufacturing Co was started in Osaka, Japan.
- 1960s Third owner Tokio Ueno developed the Cantabile pocket trumpet and one was played at the 1964 Olympic games (#8).
- 1990s All trumpet production ended and Tokio only did repairs.
- 2002 The Ueno shop closed.
- 2005 Tokio Ueno passed away.

Example #8 was measured by Nick Decarlis as having a 4" bell, 0.450" bore, and was 7.75" long (below courtesy Nick Decarlis).
