

Robert De Lacy

Brixton, London

- 1832 Robert De Lacy born in Yorkshire, England
- 1870 De Lacy moves to Brixton, #41 Millbrook Rd.
- 1871 De Lacy, professor of music, Holland Cottage, Millbrook Rd., Brixton, London; advertises as a bass singer for hire
- 1873 De Lacy, #41 Millbrook Rd, singer with St. Paul's Cathedral
- 1875 still at #41 Millbrook
- 18?? one cornet lists him at #10 Millbrook Rd (bottom left)
- 1878 now at #187 Loughborough Rd
- 1880 now at #84 Holland Rd, Brixton (the majority of marked instruments found)
- 1881 De Lacy, professor of music, #84 Holland Rd, widower
- 1882 De Lacy, bass singer for hire, #84 Holland Rd
- 1885 ad for De Lacy music store, #84 Holland Rd, new English model cornet, instrument repairs (top right)
- c1888 author of "London Brass Band & Military Journal"
- 1892 sold cornet inscribed "R De Lacy, Maker, 84 Holland, London & Paris" (2nd & 3rd photos on right)
- 1896 Robert De Lacy, #84 Holland Rd, no occupation given
- 1901 not listed under Musical Instruments in directory
- 1908 Robert De Lacy, #84 Holland Rd
