- 1859 Gilmore & Russell music store at #61 Court St. with J.M. Russell (dir)
- 1860-61 Leader of Gilmore's Band, #61 Court St. (dir)
- 1864-65 Gilmore, Graves & Co. at #18 Harvard Place (dir)
- 1866 P.S. Gilmore & Co., musical instrument maker, #18 Harvard St., Gilmore bought out Graves (dir)
- 1867 Wright, Gilmore & Co., #71 Sudbury St. (dir)
- 1868 P.S. Gilmore now at #74 Washington St. after selling business to Wright (dir)
- 1869 P.S. Gilmore's Band listed at same address (dir)
- 1873 last listing for Gilmore's Band (dir)
- 1892 Gilmore dies on September 24th at St. Louis
