- 1889 Hanson & Co, #317 Main St, Worcester (directory).
- 1900 Charles & son Arthur both listed as music dealers (census).
- 1907 Hanson & Co, #188 Main St, Worcester (directory).
- 1910 Hanson and son Arthur were proprietors of a music store and daughter Lillian (b.1869) was a music teacher (census).
- 1916 Hanson & Co, #260 Main St, Worcester (directory).
- 1918 Hanson & Co, #260 Main St (directory).
- 1920 C. F. Hanson, musical merchant, Worcester (census).
- 1921 Charles Hanson died on February 10; musician and music store owner (death certificate).
- 1930 Arthur Hanson, piano store owner (census).
- 1940 Arthur Hanson, owner of piano tuning business (census).
- 1965 Arthur died this year; ending any business (gravestone).
