

Charles Joseph Jr. & Son

Cincinnati, Ohio

- 1880 Charles Joseph Jr. (1865-1952), store clerk (census)
- 1860-1890 Kaiser & Kohler, 473 Walnut St; Frank Kaiser & William Kohler (directory)
- 1892 William Kohler, instrument repairer, 473 Walnut; Emil Kaiser, brass worker, h. rear 490 Walnut (dir)
- 1893 Charles Joseph Jr., music teacher; Emil Ballhaus, musician (dir)
- 1894 William Kohler dies at age 71 before June; now Ballhaus & Joseph, manufacturers of musical instruments, #473 Walnut, Emil Ballhaus & Charles Joseph, Jr. (dir)
- 1895 E. Joseph, successor to K&K, #473 Walnut, Charles Joseph Jr., manager; Ballhaus & Weiss, musical instruments, #57 Breman (dir)
- 1896 Joseph moves to #1325 Walnut St. (dir)
- 1900 Charles Joseph Jr., successor to K&K (dir)
- 1906 moves to #1330 Walnut; son Carl is musician (dir)
- 1908 now Charles Joseph & Son, #1330 Walnut, with son Carl W. Joseph (1886-?) (dir)
- 1910 last year listed as Joseph & Son; by April census is listed as musician
- 1911-1940 Charles listed as orchestra musician (dir)
- 1910 Carl now musical instrument repairman in Campbell, KY (census)
- 1917 Carl listed as foreman for Wurlitzer Co. in Clifton, KY (draft record)
- 1922 Carl Joseph Music Co., Albany, NY (*MTR*, Jan 22)
- 1930 Carl is a music merchant owner in Albany, NY (census)



Brass instruments labeled “Charles Joseph” (top photo from Horn-u-copia.net) would date to the 1895-1907 period. “Joseph & Son” would date to the 1908-1910 period.
