

Master Art Instruments

Elkhart, Indiana

The Master Art name was registered in 1934 by the Czechoslovak Musical Instrument Co of New York City with first use given as 3/1/1922.

Construction and serial number fonts would suggest that these were made by Pan American in Elkhart. The serial number range would put these in the 1935-1948 period.
