

Mayers & Harrison Ltd.

Manchester, England

- 1923 Mayers & Harrison buys Joseph Higham (NLI)
- 1934 Higham is sold to Premier Drum Co. (NLI)
- 1942 M&H ad says that they incorporate Joseph Higham as part of their business; #207-215 Great Jackson St, Manchester (*Brass Band News*, Oct)
- 1950 M&H ad claims sole distribution for Higham instruments (*Brass Band News*)
- 1959 former worker from this year says the shop was cluttered and run down and owned by Mr. Mayer; still doing brass repairs
- 1965 last date found stamped on bugle sold at auction (likely these were made at the Higham factory)
- 1954 ad below from *Brass Band News*
