- 1857 Wm C. Peters & Sons now includes John L. Peters
- 1858 W. C. Peters & Sons (W.C., Alfred, & John), music publishers and dealers in musical instruments, #8 E. 4th; William M. Peters, music dealer & pub., #50 W 4th (dir)
- 1859 W.C. Peters & Sons moves to #76 W. 4th. they publish "Peters' Sax-Horn Journal" (dir)
- 1860 W.C. Peters & Sons moves to #235 Broadway (dir)
- 1861 A.C. Peters & Bro. (Alfred & John), music & musical instruments, #94 W. 4th; Wm. M. Peters, music & musical instruments, #50 W. 4th; William C. Peters is no longer listed (dir)
- 1865 A.C. Peters & Bro. moves to #69 W. 4th (dir)
- 1866 both A.C. Peters & Bro. and Wm. M. Peters are at #50 W 4th (dir)
- 1867 all Peters are gone from Cincinnati directory

Top photo is William Cumming Peters (1805-1866). Bass horn shown is marked "W C Peters Cincinnati". Peters had stores in several other cities but this is the only marked instrument that I have found. Likely a stencil horn.
