

Accusonic Corp.

Grand Rapids, MI

- 1961 Accusonic Corp. is registered on August 18th in Grand Rapids, MI; Eugene A. Pilczuk (1918-1992), #6986 Baumhoff Rd. NW (photo 1)
- 1950s – 60s Gene was developing his leadpipe design while working for York in Grand Rapids (Carl Fischer owned)
- 1970s Gene perfected his stepped leadpipe while working for the original Yamaha plant in Grand Rapids (established in 1974); he works on them at his home shop
- 1983 Gene applies for a patent on his stepped design
- 1985 granted patent #4,559,859 on December 24th (photo 2)
- 1989 Accusonic Corp. is automatically dissolved on May 15th
- 1992 Gene dies at age 73 in Grand Rapids on March 30th
- 1999 Rich Ita of the Brass Instrument Workshop, Marietta, GA, buys the patent, tools, and stock of Accusonic and continues to build them

Early examples have a code number which refers to the amount of taper. Later ones have a two-number code denoting the taper. No charts exist for these although a later example like 45-58 is probably the bore size.
