- 1924 Rex International Products Inc, #57 Jay (directory)
- 1925 Rex Int. Prod. recently changed its name to Rexcraft, Inc. (*MTR*, Sept)
- 1926 Rexcraft, Inc, #57 Jay St, Brooklyn; Leslie E. McCuen, president & GM; making official BSA bugles (*MTR*, Nov, ad on top right)
- 1931 Rexcraft, Inc, #57 Jay St (phone book)
- 1933 Rexcraft was purchased by Buglecraft (Middlehorn Leader)
- 1934 Rexcraft, Inc, #80 York St (phone book)
- 1935 Rexcraft Inc, #80 York St (last year listed in phone book)
- 1985 the BSA stopped their official approval of the Rexcraft model bugle (Middlehorn Leader)
- 1996 Buglecraft is in Long Island City, NY (Middlehorn Leader)
