 - 1940 Ray Robinson, Lafayette Hotel, Brooklyn; manager for musical instruments (census)
 - 1941 Robinson Musical Instrument Accessories Inc., #571 Carol St., Brooklyn (February phone book, gone by August)
- Listed at 36 E. 21st St, New York, NY for the Music Trade Convention (*Presto*, August 1941)
