

John C. Rosenbeck

New York City

- 1800 Rosenbeck born c.1800-1810 (1840 census)
- 1835 exhibited brass trombones & other instruments at the Castle Garden Fair in NYC; judged as superior quality; from Utica; one judge, well-known player Felipe Cioffi, liked them so much that he bought an alto and tenor trombone for himself (*Journal of American Institute*)
- 1836 Rosenbeck of Utica won diploma for a trombone at the October fair at Niblo's Garden in NYC (*Journal of American Institute*)
- 1837 Rosenbeck of Utica won another trombone award at Niblo's Fair (*Fair of American Institute*)
- 1838 at #81 Division St., NYC (directory)
- 1839 John C. Rosenbeck, #1 Orchard St., NYC, won a diploma at Niblo's Garden Fair in October for a silver cornopean (newspaper article); he is also in the NYC directory
- 1839 returns to Utica (*NLI*)
- 1840 John living in Utica with wife and five children (census)
- 1857 exhibits Boehm flute in NY (*NLI*)
