

E. U. Wurlitzer Inc.

Boston, Massachusetts

- 1890 Edward Wurlitzer (1862-?) immigrates to Boston from Germany, listed as musical instrument maker (census)
- 1891 Ernest Ulrich Wurlitzer (1878-1963) immigrates to Boston from Germany and joins his uncle Edward (census)
- 1900 Edward & Ernest, musical inst. makers, living together in Boston (census)
- 1902 Ernest is naturalized in Boston
- 1910 Ernest Wurlitzer & Albert Koffe (b.1886), musical inst. makers, #68 Lockheart St., Boston; son Ernest C. is born; home at #41 Westminster St.
- 1925 Edward A. Wurlitzer, inst. maker, Boston (dir); Ernest U. Wurlitzer, instruments & repairs, #38 La Grange, Boston
- 1956 E. U. Wurlitzer Co., musical inst., Ernest pres, son Albert E. Wurlitzer (1907-?) clerk (dir)
- 1963 Ernest dies in Boston
- 1969 EU Wurlitzer Inc., #76 Bedford, Ernest pres, Albert tres, Rudolph T. Wurlitzer salesman (directory)
- 1999 EU Wurlitzer Music & Sound declares bankruptcy
