Cambridge, Maine

- 1880 Frances Louise Horne born April 19th in Cambridge, Maine to Ira & Ardella (census & Trescott)
- 1890 Louise performs on cornet for the governor in Newport
- 1892 Louise starts lessons with R. B. Hall of Waterville, ME and practices 3-4 hours a day
- 1893 Louise is soloist with Hall's Military Band
- 1896 studies with Henry C. Brown, Boston
- 1897 playing with Fadettes of Boston
- 1898 toured with Cecilia Musical Club
- 1899 summer soloist at Norumbega Park, Boston
- 1900 soloist for US Ladies Military Band, Providence, RI
- 1901 soloist for Tuxedo Ladies Band, Chester Park, Cincinnati
- 1903 played at Iroquois Theater in Chicago just before the fire
- 1906 soloist with Reno Mario & her orchestra at Symphony Hall, Boston; soloist at Rudolph Hotel, Atlantic City
- 1908 soloist with Twelve Navaho Girls, Atlantic City Pier, the Navassar Band, and at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel with Mrs. Paris Chambers
- 1910 married Edmund Stilwell of Kansas City and stopped touring
- 1920 living in Kansas City, two daughters, no occupation (census)
- 1930 & 1940 same as 1920
- 1956 Louise dies in Kansas City on September 6th
