York, PA

- 1920 Don Jacoby is born in York, PA on January 30.
 - 1926 Don starts to learn the trumpet.
 - 1930s He is the youngest student at the Ernest Williams School of Music in Brooklyn, NY.
 - 1939 Don graduates from New York University and joins the Bunny Berigan Band.
 - 1942 Don joins the Navy as a musician.
 - 1946 Leaves the Navy and joins the ABC orchestra in Chicago.
 - 1956 Don joins the CBS orchestra staff in Chicago.
- Don taught for C. G. Conn and promoted their Constellation model trumpet. He also taught in Denton, Texas.
- 1992 Don dies on December 15.
